## ABOUT THE CONCLAVE

## DATE, TIME & LOCATION

## WHAT TO BRING?

All attendees will be housed in either lean-tos or platform tents, and will have a bunk with mattress. There will be waterfront activities and showers available, so please plan accordingly. Otherwise, please pack as you would for a normal outing, and make sure to bring your Class-A uniform and sash.

All participants are required to have an official BSA medical form to turn in at check-in. Please make sure parts A and C are fully completed, part B (doctor portion) is not required for short-term camping.

## COST TO ATTEND

The event fee is \$45 but if you register and pay before May 1<sup>st</sup> you will receive a \$10 discount and only pay \$35. The event fee includes all program materials, food, and a participant patch. Please note: the cost the day of the conclave is \$55, so be sure to pre-register. Trading post items are available for pre-order, including a pocket patch, jacket patch, and conclave t-shirt, see the registration form for more information.
